Council members are appointed by WA Cabinet.

Council members work to produce quality researched information and advice papers for the Minister for Disability Services both proactively and reactively. Ideally, members have personal and/or professional networks which may alert them to emerging issues and assist them with consultation and research.

People who have skills, knowledge or experience of disability are invited to nominate for membership of the Council.

From this application process, a pool of applicants will be retained on file for possible recruitment over the next two years.
